

The regulation (EG) no. 1907/2006 (REACH Regulation) is an EU-Chemical-Regulation that entered into force on 1st June 2007.

REACH is the abbreviation of Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals.

The purpose is a strong protection level of human health and the environment.

As a downstream user we are liable for information towards the customers. We are not liable for registration of substances.

Goods, which you purchase from **Thiim A/S**, do not by definition of **REACH**, have to be registered. Chemical substances contained in our goods, which may possibly be subject to registration, have to be registered exclusively by our pre-suppliers.

We maintain contact with our suppliers to avoid that SVHC materials from being included in our products.

On the strength of our experience no materials from the ECHA Candidate List with >0.1 mass percent are included in our goods or packages.

Should our goods or packages contain SVHC materials in the future, we will inform our customers if the reporting requirements are fulfilled.
